



CRITERIA FOR UTAH ABPA CHAPTER MERITORIOUS SERVICE AWARD:

Many of you have asked questions about the Utah Chapter Meritorious Service Award. The Chapter established the criteria for the award several years ago. I have outlined the criteria below.

1. The nominee must have been actively involved in some aspect of backflow prevention and cross connection control for a minimum of five years.

This could include one or more of the following categories:

- Administer cross connection control programs.
- Providing training, instruction in cross connection control and backflow prevention.
- Install, repair and/or test of backflow prevention devices and assemblies.
- Work in public health or for a regulatory agency dealing with backflow prevention.
- Manufacture or supply backflow prevention equipment, parts, etc.
- Design and/or approve plumbing and construction plans and specifications relating to backflow prevention.
- Involved in legislative aspects of backflow prevention and cross connection control with Boards, Councils, and other elected or appointed officials.

2. And one of the following:

- Actively participate in professional association, committee, or similar group or organization that promotes cross connection control and backflow prevention.
- Other activity relating to cross connection control and backflow prevention that furthers the cause of cross connection control and backflow prevention and public health protection as determined by the Utah Chapter ABPA Board of Directors.


